



## ***ACIDC's Fall 50/50 Raffle Rules and Disclosure Statements***

1. Sales for raffle tickets for Atlantic Canadian Irish Dance Championship ("ACIDC") begin on August 12, 2021 and end on November 18, 2021 ("Raffle Period") with a final draw date of November 23 2021. The Raffle is conducted by ACIDC. The Official Rules of the Raffle are set forth herein.
2. Eligibility:
  - a. The Raffle is open to persons age 19 and older.
  - b. Tickets may be sold and purchased only in Nova Scotia.
  - c. All members of ACIDC organizing committee and their family members are eligible to purchase tickets.
3. Ticket cost options will be:
  - One for \$3.00.
  - Two for \$5.00
  - Five for \$10.00
  - Twenty for \$20.00
  - One hundred for \$50.00
4. Tickets will be sold via Experience Funding, an online ticket retailer register with Alcohol and Gaming Nova Scotia.
5. All purchasing and management of tickets will be as set out in the contract with Experience Funding.
6. ACIDC will be responsible for picking up the printed tickets from the contracted printer (Staples) and taking them to the draw location to be placed in a container with a minimum of three (3) ACIDC committee members present for the draw. Members of the ACIDC committee will draw one ticket from a container to identify a single winner and this will be filmed live. The winning ticket name will be read as the draw is conducted.
7. The final, prize-awarding draw will be on November 23, 2021 and will be official after the committee has determined that all eligibility requirements have been met. Entrants do not need to be present to win. Prizes will not be issued to anyone other than the entrant(s) whose name

is on the ticket stub.

8. Draw Location: Rising Tide Irish Dance Academy, 325 Rocky Lake Drive, Unit 3, Bedford, NS B4A 2T3.
9. Draw Date and Time: 5:30PM on November 23, 2021
10. The winner will be notified by phone on November 23, 2021
11. There will be one winner who will receive 50 % of the dollar value of all funds raised through ticket sales. Odds of winning depend on the total number of raffle tickets sold.
12. Notification. Prize winner will be notified by phone and email. A winner has 90 days to claim a prize, and every attempt has to be made to contact the winner. After 90 days, a new draw can take place. 13. Proceeds from the Raffle will benefit ACIDC and its ongoing activities for the purposes of hosting an Atlantic Canadian Irish Dance Championships. Contributions will go directly to ACIDC Committee and not individual committee members.
14. The Prize is provided via cheque to the winner.
15. The Raffle is subject to all applicable federal, provincial, and local laws and regulations, and is void wherever prohibited or restricted by law.
16. General Conditions. The Raffle is subject to these Official Rules. These Official Rules shall not be changed by any oral statement made by any employee or other person acting on behalf of ACIDC. By participating, Entrants agree: (i) to be bound by these complete Official Rules and the decisions of ACIDC which shall be final and binding; and (ii) to waive any right to claim ambiguity in the Raffle or these Official Rules, except where prohibited by law. By accepting a Prize, Winner agrees to release Atlantic Canadian Irish Dance Championship (ACIDC), its officers, directors, employees, representatives and agents, and any person or entity associated with the production, judging, or administration of the Raffle (collectively, the "Releases") from and against any claims, damages, disability, attorneys' fees, and costs of litigation and settlement, as well as any liability due to any injuries, damages or losses to any person (including death) or property of any kind resulting in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, from redemption, acceptance, possession, ownership, misuse or use of any prize or participation in any Raffle – related activity or participation in this Raffle. Except where prohibited by law, the Winner of the Raffle Ticket and acceptance of the Grand Prize constitutes permission for ACIDC to use said Winner's name, photograph, likeness, statements, biographical information, voice, and city and provincial address for promotional or advertising purposes in connection with this Raffle on a worldwide basis, and in all forms of media, now or hereafter known, in perpetuity, without

review, permission or further compensation. All Federal, Provincial and Local Taxes associated with receipt or use of the Grand Prize, including without limitation all applicable sales, use, luxury, income and special taxes are the sole responsibility of the winner. Winner must claim prize with ACIDC, and sign and deliver a completed Release Form at the time of settlement. ACIDC, reserves the right to disqualify false entries or entries suspected of being false, and any illegible, defective, incomplete or physically altered entry form and entries that do not include valid or complete payment. All sales are final unless otherwise specified in these official rules. ACIDC will reject any drawing ticket request if the payment is not honored or is returned due to insufficient funds or any other reason prior and not remedied within (7) days before the drawing. Correction of any such return or nonpayment is the sole responsibility of the ticket purchaser. All entries become the property of ACIDC and will not be returned. ACIDC reserves the right to disqualify any entrant if it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Raffle or violating these Official Rules, and reserves the right to cancel the Raffle should it suspect fraud or for reasons out of the control of ACIDC.
