

BDMHA 50/50 House Rules

1. There is one 50/50 prize. The 50/50 prize value will be equal to half the 50/50 ticket sales revenue.
2. Tickets for the 50/50 raffle are priced as follows: 1 paper ticket for \$2.00. Online e-tickets are 3 for \$5.00, 7 for \$10.00 and 15 for \$20.00.
3. Tickets can only be sold within NS. People visiting from outside of NS can purchase paper tickets only - not e-tickets. Tickets cannot be taken out of the province to sell.
4. Only BDMHA members can participate in the selling of 50/50 tickets.
5. BDMHA will collect and track all monies in a separate bank account for 50/50 revenue.
6. All unsold tickets must be returned at the end of the fundraiser.
7. A valid ticket for any draw is a ticket:
 - a) issued by BDMHA for the purpose of the 50/50 draw;
 - b) with the proper name and telephone number on the ticket written in a clear and concise manner so that it can be easily read;
 - c) printed by Print 101 or such other printer so long as one sole printer printed all the tickets; and
 - d) paid for in full.
8. All e-tickets will be printed out and placed in the same barrel as the paper tickets. One 50/50 ticket will be drawn randomly by someone not associated with BDMHA. Two other people will be present to witness the draw. The draw will be available "LIVE" on Facebook (Bedford & District Minor Hockey Association). The name and ticket number of the winning ticket holder will be posted on the BDMHA Facebook page and website (bedfordblues.com).
9. The winner will be contacted by telephone and given instructions on how to claim his/her prize.
10. The prize draw will be held at the BMO Centre, Hammonds Plains, NS March 15, 2020 @ 6:00pm. The winner need not be present to claim his/her prize.
11. The winner has 90 days to claim his/her prize. If the prize is not claimed within that time, the prize will be forfeited and a second winner selected who will have 90 days to claim their prize.
12. There are no refunds on tickets.
13. No one associated with 'Experience Funding.ca' will be eligible to participate in this 50/50 draw.

*Print 101 is printing both the e-tickets and the paper tickets, so the stubs for both will be identical.
