House Rules Middleton Fire Department

1. **Prize's** consist of 3 draws: 1 SEA'scape Getaway Package for 2 ppl, 1 \$250.00 VISA, 1 \$100.00 VISA. The Prizes are being offered to the winner of the Lottery by Middleton Fire Department.
2. **The Lottery Tickets** are being printed under the direction Experience Funding .ca ticket stub portion will remain with the Middleton Fire Department.
3. **The Draw** shall take place at 49 Church Street on March 31, 2021. The draw will take place at 6:30 pm The draw will take place in front of 2 independent witnesses. The draw will be managed and supervised at all times by the Licensee. The name and contact details of the Independent Volunteer drawing the ticket and two persons acting as official witnesses will be recorded and retained. The draw will be executed by removing one single ticket stub from the container per prize.
4. **The Announcement** will be live streamed. The announcement will declare by name / number on the winning ticket.
5. **In order to be declared a Winner** the Middleton Fire Department must be able to prove through its customer records that the winning ticket was purchased by a named customer recorded in the Middleton Fire Department database. A winner does not need to be present for the draw to qualify as a winner.
6. **The Winner** agrees that Middleton Fire Department can publicly advertise the winner and details of the prize. The winner shall not be compensated for such participation.
7. **Security of Tickets and Stubs** shall be afforded under the control of Middleton Fire Department and Experience Funding.ca. At the end date as declared Experience Funding.ca software has an admin portal that will allow the client to login to their specific online raffle and download a CSV file This CSV file will have all required ticket data that is specified by Service Nova Scotia's Alcohol and gaming division. Experience Funding.ca has secured a printing contract with any Staples locations in Atlantic Canada. 48 hours will be granted to print the tickets. Tickets shall be kept in a secure locations for 100 days after the draws.

8. **Middleton Fire Department** members and their spouse, common-law partner or conjugal partner will not be eligible to purchase lottery tickets in their own name because of the independent nature of the draw and the degree of security being afforded the ticket and stub control.
9. **The prizes are not refundable.** No Replacement will be issued,
10. **The Proceeds of the Lottery** shall accrue to the Middleton Fire Department, a not-for-profit, registered Fire Department. Middleton Fire Department shall utilize the funds to support the new fire hall project.
11. **The Geographic location of the Lottery** is the Province of Nova Scotia and no tickets will be offered for sale outside of Nova Scotia.
12. **Minimum age of a Participant** is 19 Years of Age. No ticket shall be sold to persons under the Age of 19 and the winner must be 19 Years of Age or older.
13. **The nominal cash value** of the prizes have no cash value.
14. **The last date and time for qualifying tickets sales** shall be March 28th at midnight 2021.
15. **A Second Draw** a winner has 90 days after the initial winning draw to claim a prize, and every attempt has to be made to contact the winner. If the winner from the first draw cannot be contacted after 90 days a new draw can take place.
16. **House Rules** shall be posted at the Middleton Fire Department office/ website throughout the Lottery license duration.
