

Rules of Play for 50/50 Online Raffle
Jazz East Rising Association

1. Jazz East Rising Association is a non-profit charitable organization based in Halifax, Nova Scotia whose mission is to create vibrant musical experiences for our communities through performance, education, and outreach
2. The lottery will take place from July 14, 2021 through August 15, 2021.
3. Tickets are 1 for \$10, 3 for \$20, 10 for \$50 and 40 for \$100.
4. Tickets will only be available via the online purchase website ExperienceFunding.com. Purchasers must provide their first name, last name, address, telephone number and e-mail as part of the purchase process and must purchase tickets only with a valid credit card via a secure payment gateway.
5. Tickets will be sold using a certified online raffle system supplied by Experience Funding.
6. After buying, purchasers will be presented a downloadable and printable ticket/receipt with their 50/50 registered numbers. Numbers purchased will be stored electronically along with the purchasers' purchase history and information.
7. At the end date of the raffle a CSV file will be downloaded and tickets will be printed at Staples. The tickets will be picked up by Andrea Dawson Thomas and put into a box for the draw.
8. The amount of the 50/50 will be broadcast and updated live (in real time) on the website.
9. The winning number will be featured on the website after the draw (5:00 PM ADT, August 17, 2021); additionally, the winner will be contacted via telephone and e-mail per the information they submit at time of online purchase.
10. Upon verification of the winner's identity and age, via a scan of a valid provincial or federal photo identification card (i.e., driver's license, firearm possession permit, passport, etc.), the winner will be sent payment via e-transfer.
11. The winning ticket holder has 6 months in which to claim their prize from the date of the draw their ticket was purchased for.
12. The winner must provide his/her name, address and phone number with picture identification for our report sheet. A scan of a valid provincial or federal photo identification card (i.e., driver's license, firearm possession permit, passport, etc.) is acceptable.
13. Once the certified winner is verified, and provides identification with photo ID, they will be sent an e-transfer in the amount of the declared prize which is, at minimum, 50% of the total sales for that game. If the winner cannot provide photo ID, then the winning proceeds will be held until such identification can be provided.
14. The winner's name will be broadcast/posted on the website and publicized via Jazz East Rising's Facebook and Instagram accounts.

15. In the event that attempts to contact the winner are unsuccessful, the winning stub will be kept in a locked filing cabinet for 6 months. After that time period has elapsed the prize will be donated to a charity with the approval of Nova Scotia Alcohol & Gaming
