

1. Three prizes will be awarded in this lottery
 - a. Early bird prize #1 [July 30, 2019]: Weekend in the City package valued at \$500 and includes hotel accommodations, dinner and theatre vouchers.
 - b. Early bird prize #2 [August 27, 2019]: Travel package for two valued at \$3500 and includes airfare and hotel accommodations.
 - c. Grand Prize [October 1, 2019]: 50% (half) of ticket sales from June 24, 2019 – September 29, 2019.
2. Ticket sales will begin Monday, June 24, 2019 and end Sunday, September 28, 2019.
3. Tickets for this lottery cost \$2 each. Tickets are payable by cash, cheque, debit or credit card. Tickets are non-refundable. Tickets can be ordered online, by phone, or at any Nova Scotia SPCA shelter across the province. Outside ticket locations may be secured after these house rules are in place and will be attached as an addendum to these rules. One ticket per draw will be selected at random.
 - a. Players can purchase tickets online through ExperienceFunding.ca. A minimum of five tickets (\$10) must be purchased online. ExperienceFunding.ca will verify the player lives in Nova Scotia. Tickets and confirmation will be emailed to the player; no physical tickets will be required.
 - b. Players purchasing by phone must provide a valid Nova Scotia address to purchase along with a credit card number. Player's tickets will be mailed to them.
 - c. Players purchasing in person at any Nova Scotia SPCA shelter or third-party ticket seller will be offered their ticket stubs at the time of purchase.
 - d. Ticket stubs *do not* need to be physically exchanged for any winning prize however players are encouraged to keep their physical tickets or confirmations for reference to their designated ticket number and lottery information provided on the ticket.
 - e. In the event that someone receives a ticket with another person's name on it in error by mail and that person's name is drawn as the winner, the person in whose name the ticket is printed shall be declared the winner.
4. The prize draw dates are as follows:
 - Early Bird Prize #1: Tuesday, July 30, 2019. Draw will be held at 3pm.

**Only tickets sold by midnight, Sunday, July 28, 2019 will be eligible for this draw. All tickets sold after that period will be entered into the following draw and ultimately the grand prize.*

- Early Bird #2: Tuesday, August 27, 2019. Draw will be held at 3pm.

**Only tickets sold by midnight, Sunday, August 25, 2019 will be eligible for this draw. All tickets sold after that period will be entered into only the grand prize draw.*

- GRAND PRIZE 50/50 Draw: Tuesday, October 1, 2019. Draw will be held at 3pm.

**Only tickets sold by midnight Sunday, September 29, 2019 will be eligible for the grand prize draw. Ticket sales end at midnight on Sunday, September 29, 2019.*

All draws will be made at the Nova Scotia SPCA Provincial Office at 7 Scarfe Crt in Dartmouth, Nova Scotia B3B 1W4 at 3pm on the date of the draw and be live streamed at www.facebook.com/nsspca.pas

5. PRIZE CLAIM:

- a. All winners will be announced via live video at www.facebook.com/nsspca.pas.
 - b. Winner need not be present to win.
 - c. Winners will also be notified by phone call and/or email by a representative from **The Nova Scotia SPCA** as to what they have won and where to claim their prize(s).
 - d. Winners must present a valid ID, confirming their identity, prior to prize being awarded.
 - e. A list of winners will be made available online at www.novascotiaspca.ca
 - f. Winning tickets for Early Bird Prizes will be placed back in for the Grand Prize draw.
 - g. Prizes not claimed by January 1, 2020 will be forfeited and an alternate winner will be selected.
6. By purchasing a ticket, purchaser agrees to allow the Nova Scotia SPCA to use purchaser's name and image without compensation for any promotional activity related to this or any future raffle. The Nova Scotia SPCA will not share purchaser's address or contact information. Multiple public announcements will be made including social media and web based digital announcements.
7. By purchasing a ticket the purchaser agrees to release the Nova Scotia SPCA and its prize partners from any and all liability for losses, damages, injury or illness resulting from participation in any of our prize packages.
8. Paid staff at the Nova Scotia SPCA Provincial Office and members of the Board of Directors or any member of their household cannot participate.
9. **Tickets must be purchased in Nova Scotia by Nova Scotia residents only. Ticket purchasers must be 19 years of age or older.** Ticket purchases are not eligible for tax receipts.
10. The Nova Scotia SPCA will record and track all ticket sales and a record will be kept that states the winner of the ticket draw prize and the prize they won.
11. All Raffle proceeds will support the Nova Scotia SPCA's mission, programs and services. Net revenues from tickets purchased in a specific community (i.e. Designated Nova Scotia SPCA Shelter regions) stay in that community.

With respect to the early bird prize packages:

Travel Package

- 1) Fees, air fare taxes, surcharges, insurance and a \$25 per person processing fee are the responsibility of the guests travelling. Vouchers do not include optional fees such as checked bags, additional transportation, or food. Paid upgrades are the responsibility of the guests and subject to availability
- 2) Vouchers are limited and subject to promotional space and availability of eligible fare options and flight schedules. Not all flights have promotional space.
- 3) Airfare must be booked within one year from the date of purchase. Trip must be booked a minimum of 60 days before flight date.
- 4) Trip vouchers are valid for one roundtrip flight for two guests only. All guests must travel together on the same itinerary, dates and flights.
- 5) Flights booked must be roundtrip to and from the same locations. Flights must depart from city A to city B and return from city B to city A.
- 6) Vouchers may not be available on some dates such as statutory holidays, peak travel dates, and blackout dates. Blackout dates: Thanksgiving (U.S.), Christmas, and New Year's weeks. 2019: Feb 14-18; Apr 17-22; Nov 7-11; Dec 24 - Jan 1, 2020
- 7) Vouchers may become null and void if any booking is cancelled by the user after being confirmed.
- 8) The individual booking the flight through the travel package must be of or over the age of majority in their province.
- 9) No voucher can be sold. In the event that a voucher has been sold, the voucher will become void and any bookings made with the voucher will be cancelled without notice or reimbursement.
- 10) The Nova Scotia SPCA and its prize partners will not be responsible for lost or mishandled vouchers. Once a voucher has been delivered to you, you are responsible for it. Reservations are subject to availability and hotel may be substituted for comparable or better property. Certificates cannot be replaced if lost, stolen or destroyed. All purchases are non-refundable. Packages cannot be resold. Suggested retail value is calculated using tariff air rates and rack room rates. Ground transportation is not included.
- 11) In the unlikely event that a prize partner ceases to operate the corresponding voucher will become null and void.

Weekend in the City Package

- 1) All vouchers are limited and subject to promotional space and availability.
- 2) Hotel voucher may not be redeemable on some dates such as statutory holidays, peak travel dates, and blackout dates. Winner must contact hotel directly to confirm availability.
- 3) Hotel vouchers are valid for a two-night stay in one room. Vouchers must be used for the same room for consecutive nights. Paid upgrades are the responsibility of the guests and are subject to availability.
- 4) Theatre vouchers can only be used for Neptune Theatre's production of Peter Pan. Vouchers are limited to availability at the time of booking. Book early to ensure your vouchers can be used. Vouchers cannot be exchanged for gift certificates or used for any Neptune Theatre performance other than Peter Pan. Vouchers can be redeemed by phone or in-person at Neptune Theatre.
