

The Halifax Tool Library Society (HTL)

HTL's Holiday Raffle and 50/50 Rules and Disclosure Statements

1. Sales for Raffle Grand Prize (generator & jerrycan) and 50/50 tickets for Halifax Tool Library Society ("HTL") begin on November 22nd, 2021 and end on December 20th, 2021 ("Raffle Period") with an "Early-bird" prize draw date of December 7th, 2021. The Raffle is conducted by HTL. The Official Rules of the Raffle are set forth herein.
2. Eligibility:
 - a. The Raffle is open to persons age 19 and older.
 - b. Tickets may be sold and purchased only in Nova Scotia.
 - c. All members of the HTL and their family members are eligible to purchase tickets.
 - d. All members of the HTL board of directors and their immediate family members are ineligible to purchase tickets.
3. Raffle Ticket cost options will be:
One for \$5.00
Three for \$10.00
Ten for \$20.00
4. 50/50 Ticket cost options will be:
One for \$3.00.
Five for \$10.00
Twenty for \$20.00
5. Tickets will be sold via Experience Funding, an online ticket retailer registered with Alcohol and Gaming Nova Scotia.
6. All purchasing and management of tickets will be as set out in the contract with Experience Funding.
7. The HTL will be responsible for picking up the printed tickets from the contracted printer (Staples) and taking them to the draw location to be placed in a container with a minimum of three (3) HTL committee members present for the draw. Members of the HTL committee will draw one ticket from a container to identify a single winner and this will be filmed live. The winning ticket names will be read as each draw is conducted.
8. The final Grand Prize-awarding draw will be on December 21st, 2021 and will be official after the committee has determined that all eligibility requirements have been met. Entrants do not need to be present to win. Prizes will not be issued to anyone other than the entrant(s) whose name is on the ticket stub.
9. Draw Location: The Halifax Tool Library 3115 Veith St, Halifax, NS B3K 3G9
10. Draw Date and Time: 7:00pm on December 21st, 2021
11. The winners will be initially notified by phone on December 21st, 2021
12. There will be one winner of the raffle prize (generator) who will have 90 days to take possession of said prize. Odds of winning depend on the total number of raffle tickets sold.
13. The HTL will offer "Early-bird" prizes of HTL Annual Memberships. These prizes will be drawn at 7:00pm on December 7th, 2021. Initially the HTL will draw for two Annual Memberships and will draw for two additional memberships for every \$250.00 raised, over and above \$250.00. Entrants who have purchased raffle tickets by 12:00pm on the 6th of December will be entered in the "Early-bird" prize draw. These entrants and the winners of the "Early-bird" prizes will be eligible to win the Grand Prize when drawn.

14. There will be one winner of the 50/50 raffle, who will receive 50% of the dollar value of all funds raised through 50/50 ticket sales. Odds of winning depend on the total number of raffle tickets sold.

15. Notification. Prize winners will be notified by phone and email. A winner has 90 days to claim a prize, and every attempt has to be made to contact the winner. After 90 days, a new draw can take place. The Winner will be posted within 24 hours after the final drawing and may be obtained visiting <https://www.facebook.com/>.

16. Proceeds from the Raffle will benefit the HTL and its ongoing activities including for the purpose of supporting the operational expenses of the Halifax Tool Library Society. Contributions will go directly to the HTL Society and not individual committee members.

17. The 50/50 raffle prize is provided via cheque or e-transfer to the winner.

18. The Raffle is subject to all applicable federal, provincial, and local laws and regulations, and is void wherever prohibited or restricted by law.

19. General Conditions. The Raffle is subject to these Official Rules. These Official Rules shall not be changed by any oral statement made by any employee or other person acting on behalf of the HTL. By participating, Entrants agree: (i) to be bound by these complete Official Rules and the decisions of the HTL which shall be final and binding; and (ii) to waive any right to claim ambiguity in the Raffle or these Official Rules, except where prohibited by law. By accepting a Prize, Winner agrees to release Halifax Tool Library Society (HTL), its officers, directors, employees, representatives and agents, and any person or entity associated with the production, judging, or administration of the Raffle (collectively, the “Releases”) from and against any claims, damages, disability, attorneys’ fees, and costs of litigation and settlement, as well as any liability due to any injuries, damages or losses to any person (including death) or property of any kind resulting in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, from redemption, acceptance, possession, ownership, misuse or use of any prize or participation in any Raffle – related activity or participation in this Raffle. Except where prohibited by law, the Winner of the Raffle Ticket and acceptance of the Grand Prize constitutes permission for the HTL to use said Winner’s name, photograph, likeness, statements, biographical information, voice, and city and provincial address for promotional or advertising purposes in connection with this Raffle on a worldwide basis, and in all forms of media, now or hereafter known, in perpetuity, without the Halifax Tool Library Society’s annual review, permission or further compensation. All Federal, Provincial and Local Taxes associated with receipt or use of the Grand Prize, including without limitation all applicable sales, use, luxury, income and special taxes are the sole responsibility of the winner. Winner must claim the prize with HTL, and sign and deliver a completed Release Form at the time of settlement. The HTL reserves the right to disqualify false entries or entries suspected of being false, and any illegible, defective, incomplete or physically altered entry form and entries that do not include valid or complete payment. All sales are final unless otherwise specified in these official rules. HTL will reject any drawing ticket request if the payment is not honored or is returned due to insufficient funds or any other reason prior and not remedied within (7) days before the drawing. Correction of any such return or nonpayment is the sole responsibility of the ticket purchaser. All entries become the property of HTL and will not be returned. The HTL reserves the right to disqualify any entrant if it is found to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Raffle or violating these Official Rules, and reserves the right to cancel the Raffle should it suspect fraud or for reasons out of the control of the HTL.
